Motion to accept the departmental reports was made by Council Member Hooker. Seconded by Council Member Snowden. Vote: 7 For – 0 Against.

4. Consideration, discussion, and possible action to elect a member of the City Council to serve a one-year term as the Mayor Pro-Tem.

Motion to elect Council Member Gil Burrell as Mayor Pro-Tem was made by Council Member Hooker. Seconded by Council Member Snowden. Vote: 7 For – 0 Against.

5. Discussion on the library.

City Manager Tom Bolt addressed Council and stated that Council Member Davies was approached by a volunteer at the library. The library is in a county owned facility and is operated by volunteers. It currently has 2,300 members. The volunteers would like the City of Manor to oversee the operations and the staffing of the library. Mr. Bolt explained that the expense to operate the library is unknown and there is no budget.

6. Discussion to amend the Fee Ordinance for schools.

Mr. Bolt stated that Manor ISD requested a reduction in the building permit fees. Manor ISD also asked if we would consider amending our building permit fees to accommodate schools. Manor ISD provided a list of fees for the surrounding cities.

7. Consideration, discussion, and possible action of a Ribbon Cutting/Opening Ceremony for the new Jennie Lane Park Playscape.

Motion to organize a ribbon cutting ceremony for Jennie Lane Park was made by Council Member Burrell. Seconded by Council Member Kruppa. Vote: 7 For – 0 Against.
