City of Manor Municipal Court Warrant Forgiveness Program for February and March of 2019

Manor – The City of Manor will be conducting a “Warrant Forgiveness Program” from February 19, 2019 to March 15, 2019 on all outstanding warrants pending before the Manor Municipal Court. Many cities across the State of Texas conduct such programs at different times throughout the year, focusing on violators with outstanding Class C Misdemeanor Warrants, most of which are traffic related.

The Warrant Forgiveness Program offers an opportunity for the court to be proactive with its case resolution while allowing defendants an opportunity to take care of their business voluntarily and avoid possible arrest. Furthermore, this program allows a court to resolve and dispose of active warrants by focusing on a period of time during which a warrant may be recalled.

Persons with outstanding warrants can avoid arrest by coming into the City of Manor Municipal Court at 105 E. Eggleston, Manor, Texas, and making appropriate arrangements with the Court. No arrest will be made at the Court Office of individuals that voluntarily appear before the Court and makes a good faith effort to resolve the arrest warrant before the warrant is executed. If you are convicted of an offense and unable to pay the fine and court costs, you may have the court assess your ability to pay and the court may provide alternatives to full payment in satisfying the judgment.
